This report provides details on funds raised by the **Humanitarian African Relief Organization (HARO)**, with the support of the Somali diaspora community in Minneapolis, Minnesota (USA). The donation, and internal fund raising totaling 110,000 USD, which exchanged to Ethiopian birr **15,400,000. birr** fifteen million Four hundred thousand birr only was intended to assist patients suffering from kidney failure at the Jigjiga Referral Hospital.

2. Total Funds Raised and Source

Ferfer is located Far East region of Ethiopia having maximum rainfall 250mm annually also lies 400m above sea level the area is very populated approximately 10000 individuals which doesn't have enough food.

- Duration: the timeframe of the program will be one event that is April 2025.

2. Distribution Details:

- Food Commodities:

The type of food being distributed is rice, flour and cooking oils which is very essential for local normal life.

- Ration Size:

Each beneficiary/households received monthly packages means households' level package of ration.

- Distribution Methods:

Methods of the food distribution being delivered were directly to the beneficiaries, through a distribution centre.

- Number of Beneficiaries: 164households are being served
- Inclusiveness: equal opportunities for receiving (e.g., age, gender, race, colour) that means transparency distribution to the beneficiaries.
- Vulnerability: there are specific categories of vulnerability within the beneficiary population (e.g., elderly, children, pregnant women and families having no normal food are among those benefited)

4. Cost Analysis:

- Total Cost: the overall cost of the program is 4500\$ (including cost of food and transportation only)

- Cost per Beneficiary: the average food and cost of providing food assistance to one beneficiary/households got 14.5kg of rice, 14.5kg of flours, and 3liters of cooking oils.
- According to the cost wise, each beneficiary/households got 3,205 which is equivalent to half month normal package foods.

5. Logistical Challenges:

Quality Storage and Transportation: good storage of food and quality status was in place also there was no problem of transportation.

6. Impact Assessment:

Food Security: the impact of the food security program of the beneficiaries is having reliable access to a sufficient quantity of food, nutrition.

- Nutritional Status: there are improvements in the nutritional status of the beneficiaries like-
 - a) Better improvements of the people
 - b) Individual healthy recovery
 - c) The health and well-being of individuals and populations became normal.
 - d) Reduced stress and improved morality

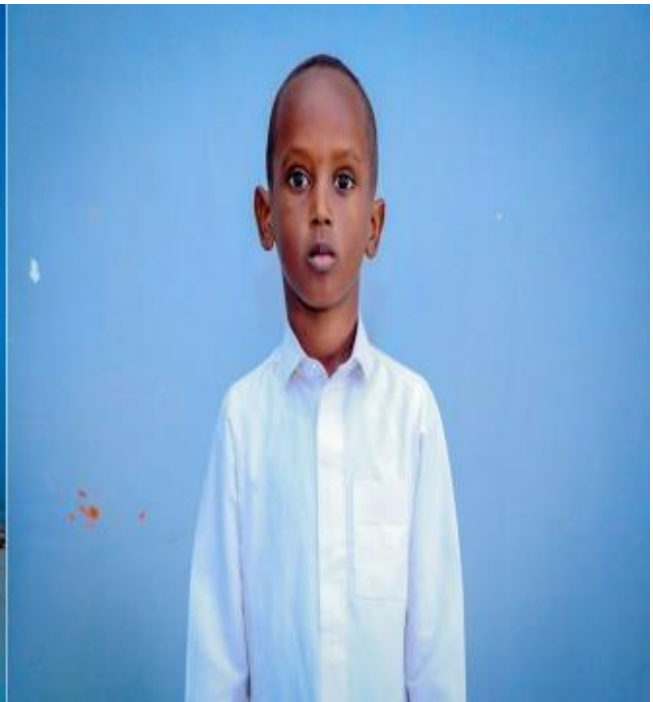
